

April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022

President Wahlig called the meeting to order at 10:00 am. Attending were President Wahlig, Member Adams and Member Poor. Absent was Vice President Selman and Member Carpenter. Also attending was Event Coordinator Tabitha Griva, Superintendent Hanna, guest Josh Teagarden and Troy Yohey.

**Special Guest Disc Golf Tournament** -Josh Teagarden stated that he is looking to host the very first Disc Golf Tournament which would entail using the course, a place to park and a place to setup. Member Poor asked Josh how many teams would he anticipate in participating. Josh replied that it would be a singles tournament and there would be 72 players. Member Poor asked if it would be a shot gun start. Josh answered yes. President Wahlig asked if Josh had any dates in mind when he wanted this to take place. Josh replied June 18th and July 16<sup>th</sup> to be a possibility. Wahlig asks if any organization would be involved for this to take place so soon. Teagarden replied no he would be putting the teams together and get local businesses to donate prizes. Supt Hanna asked what kind of costs it would be for any one participating. Teagarden stated all the money that comes in will go back to the players, other than the small fee going back to the DGA. Teagarden said the lowest is \$20.00 per division, which is a small payout, but he would charge \$35.00- \$40.00 per player so they are able to pay off the sanction fee and give back to the players. Teagarden stated this would be an amateur event where prizes would be paid out by merchandise through a disc shop. Poor asked how long the tournament would take. Teagarden replied 10AM-6PM. President Wahlig asks what he would need from the parks to help. Teagarden responded the use of the facility, parking lot, bathrooms, and the Timber Frame. Yohey states at \$35.00 per player times 72 players totals \$2,520.00 and Teagarden would be required by PGA to pay 85% payout which that leaving 15%, which would be \$378 to pay for the sanctioning fee leaving around \$140. They would use that money for drinks, trophies, and marketing. Yohey states they will not be making any money from this tournament, if anything they will be putting money into the tournament themselves. Supt. Hanna states it would be a good idea to allow them to have the tournament. President Wahlig agreed. Member Poor agreed. Hanna asked Teagarden if the July date would work. Teagarden replied yes.

The minutes of the March 2nd, 2022, meeting were approved with a motion by Member Adams and seconded by Member Poor. All were in favor

#### OLD BUSINESS

**Young Child Family Fair**- Griva stated it was great turnout with well over one hundred people at one time. It was so good, that we look forward to making it an annual event. Member Adams asked if we made it an annual event would other daycares be able to be involved. Griva replied it was Miss Roxy's Daycare putting on the event for people to get informed about all the local resources that are available for raising young children. Member Adams asked if another daycare asked to be involved in the event next year, would it be okay. Supt. Hanna stated he didn't feel it was about a competition, it's more of an informal event.

#### NEW BUSINESS

**Easter**- Griva stated Easter was set to go. We will be doing prizes in a bag, to speed the prize line up. Volunteers are all lined up, which include Trine Fraternities, NHS members, AHS students, a couple from Ruoff Mortgage.





President Wahlig states that the basketball courts are used nonstop throughout the day. Member Poor stated that tournaments he has seen in the past, they would be open through the day, just blocked during the tournament hours. Member Poor suggested to see how the Disc Golf tournament runs and use that event as a baseline. Supt. Hanna suggested if anyone is interested in having tournaments, come to park board meetings and have a questionnaire for them. President Wahlig suggested we could possibly have an application for anyone to fill out if they are wanting to rent the facilities. Supt. Hanna stated he we will put a document together that the park board could look over at the next meeting.

#### OTHER BUSINESS

**Steuben County Soil and Water Conversation District** – Supt. Hanna stated Amy Wentworth has contacted him from Steuben County Soil and Water Conversation District. They are doing a self-guided conservation practice tour through Steuben County. One of the sites they are wanting to include is the constructive wetland back off the path by the ditch. Matt stated they are wanting to know if they could put up a temporary sign letting people know they are at the right site. President Wahlig replied she is okay with the sign being there temporarily.
