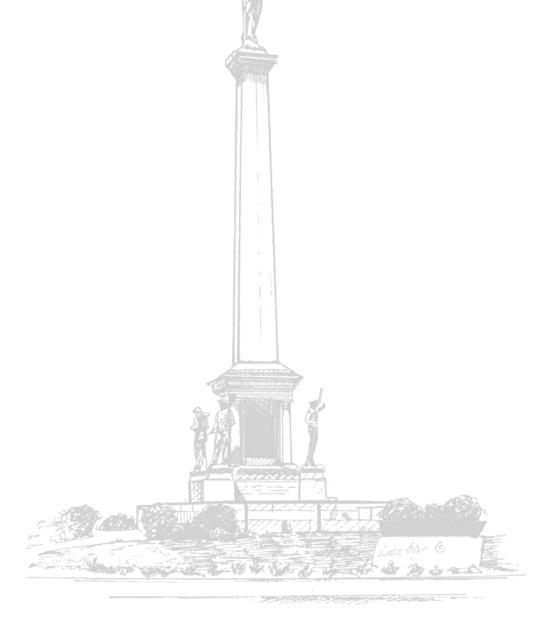

Ordinance No. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA. (1850 N SR 827), was read by title and presented to Council for third and final reading. Council Member Olson having reviewed the findings of the Plan Commission and taking into account the comprehensive plan, current conditions and character of the structures and uses in each district, the most desirable use of the land in its current and proposed zones, conservation of property value throughout the city, and responsible growth and development moved to adopt the proposed zoning change. Council Member Sharkey seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Ordinance No. 1772-2025. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGOLA AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEWAGE WORKS REVENUE BONDS FOR

THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO PAY THE COST OF CERTAIN ADDITIONS, EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SEWAGE WORKS OF SAID CITY, THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS TO PROVIDE FOR THE COST THEREOF, THE COLLECTION, SEGREGATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE REVENUES OF SAID WORKS, PROVIDING FOR THE SAFEGUARDING OF THE INTERESTS OF THE OWNERS OF SAID BONDS, OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH, INCLUDING THE ISSUANCE OF NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF BONDS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH. was read by title and presented to Council on second reading. Council Member Olson moved to approve. Council Member McDermid seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Resolution No. 2025-888, A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA, DETERMINING THAT THERE EXISTS A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN A 2023 SILVERADO TRUCK FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AT A SUBSTANTIAL SAVINGS TO THE CITY, was read by title and presented to Council for approval. 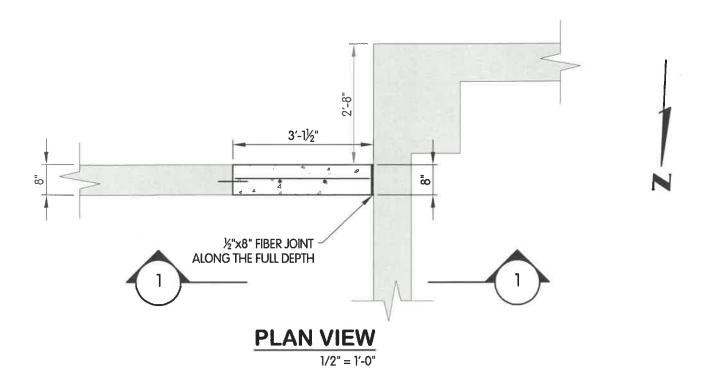

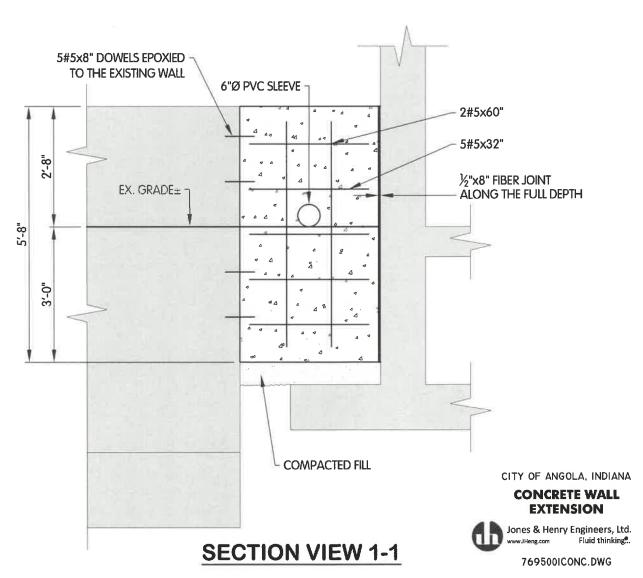
