



Notes:

- The entrance shall be maintained in a condition that will prevent tracking or flowing sediment onto public rights-of-way. This may require top dressing, repair and/or cleanout of any measures used to trap sediment.
- 2. When necessary, wheels shall be cleaned prior to entrance onto public right-of-way.
- 3. When washing is required, it shall be done on an area that drains into an approved sediment trap or sediment basin.
- 4. Gravel construction entrances shall be inspected weekly and after each significant
- storm (1-in. in 24-hr.). Maintain the gravel pad in a condition to prevent mud or sediment from leaving the construction site. Replace the gravel when voids have developed. Immediately remove all objectionable materials spilled, washed, or tracked onto public roadways. Remove all sediment deposited on paved roadways within 24 hours.
